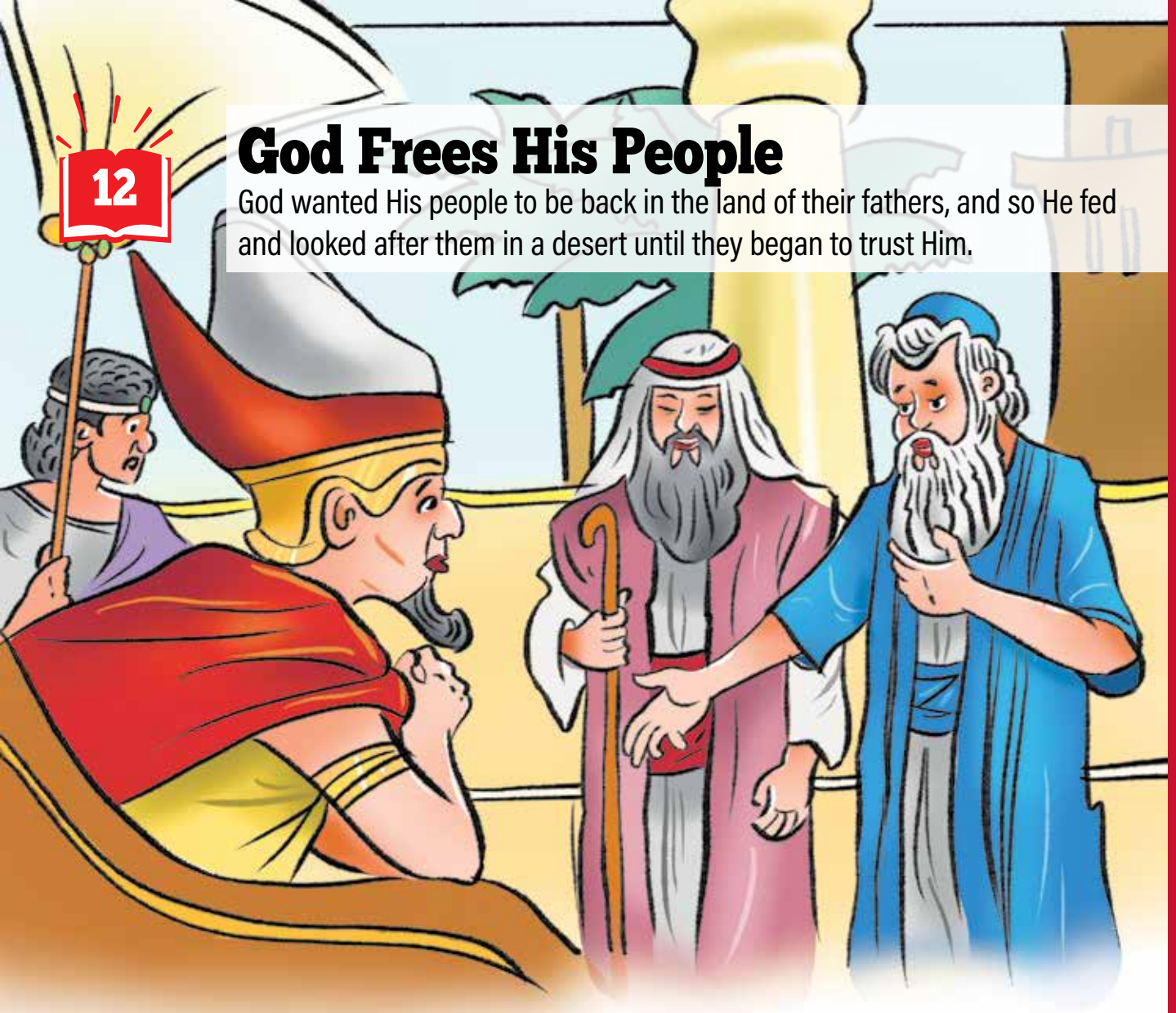


God Frees His People

God wanted His people to be back in the land of their fathers, and so He fed and looked after them in a desert until they began to trust Him.



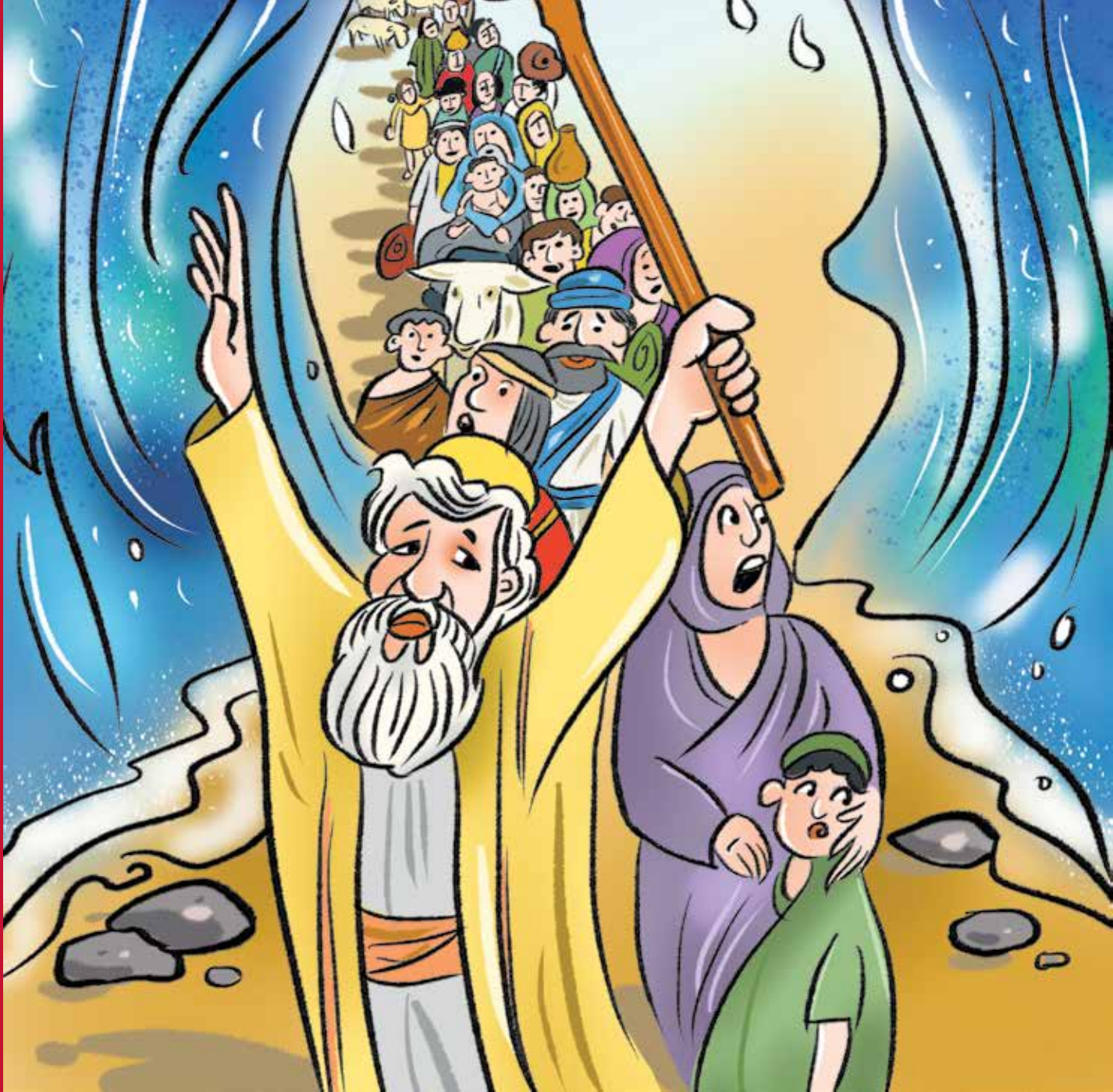
