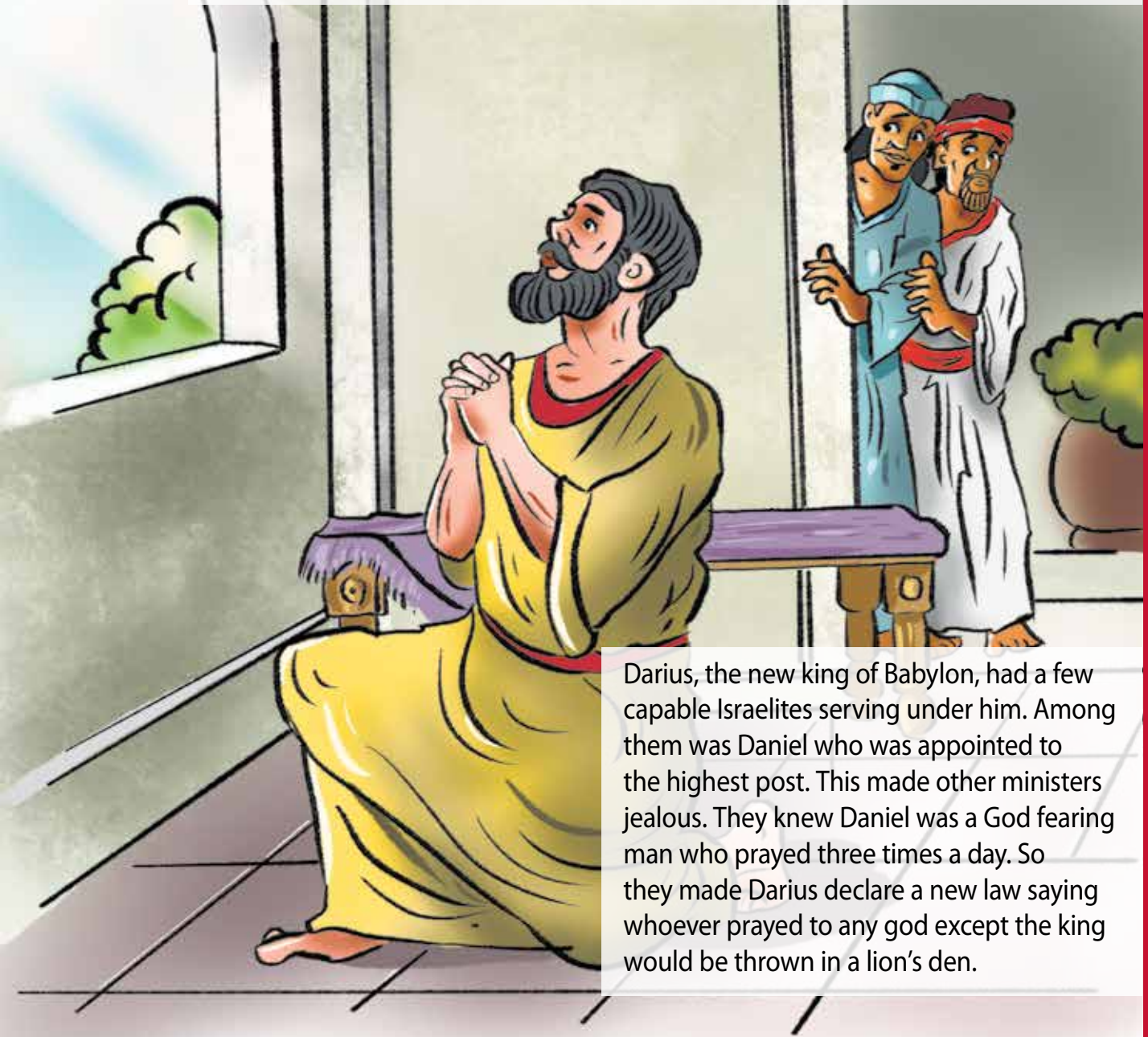




Daniel
