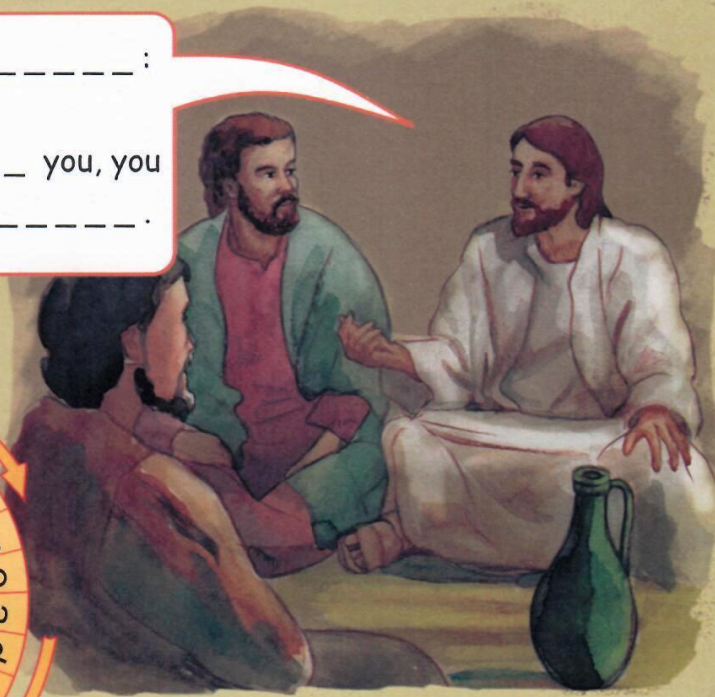


Loving Others

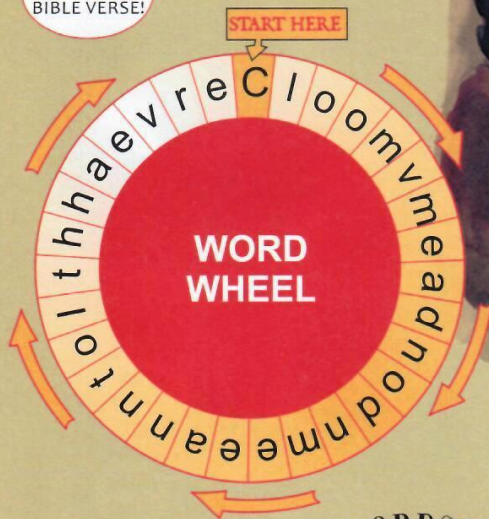
JESUS GIVES A NEW COMMANDMENT
