Walking with Jesus through the Mass


Once two of Jesus' friends were walking from Jerusalem to a place called Emmaus. They were talking about the terrible things that had happened to their beloved Master.

They sat down to have supper. As the man broke the bread, they realised it was Jesus! At that very moment he disappeared.

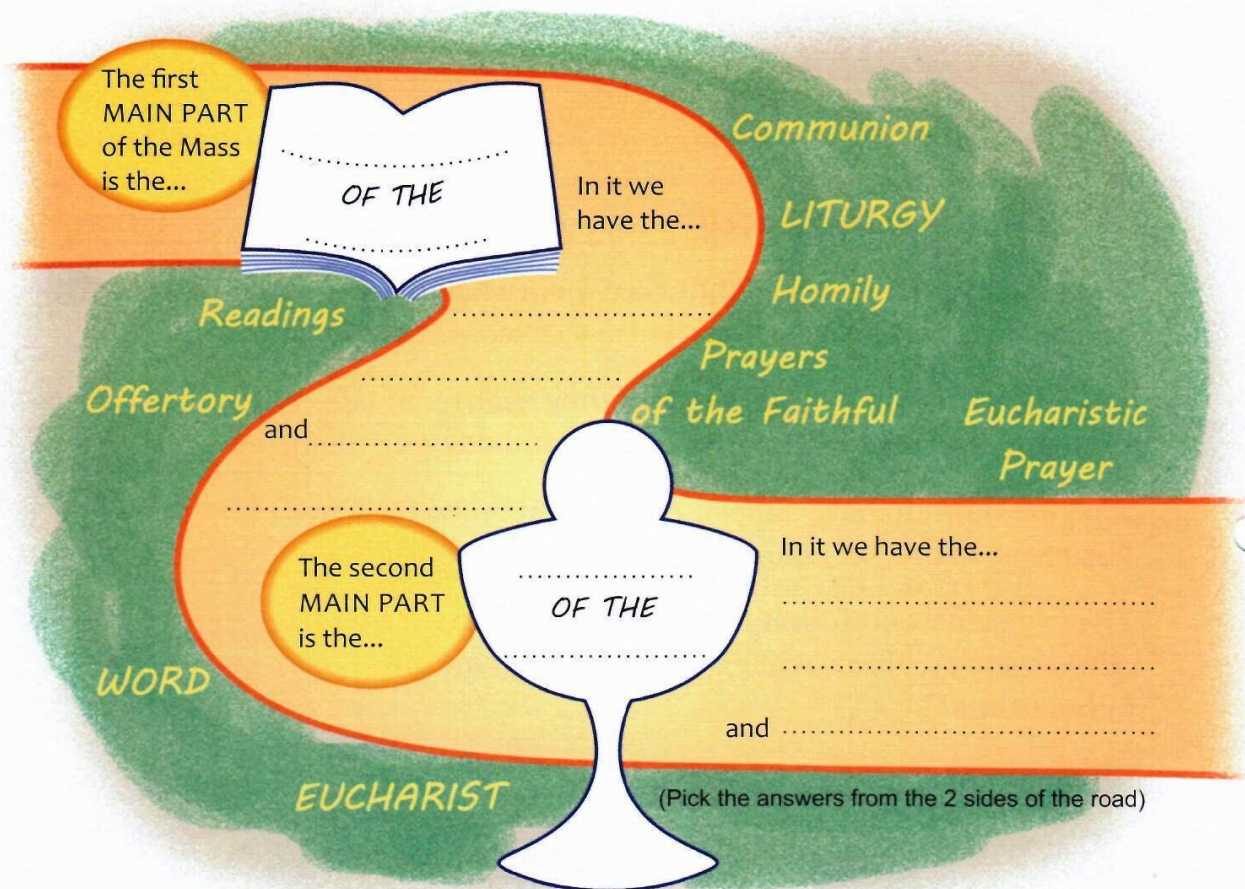
The two men went running back to Jerusalem to tell the other disciples, "Jesus really is alive! We met him and talked to him!"
