Thomas was confused and afraid. He knew something terrible was about to happen because his master Jesus had just told him so.

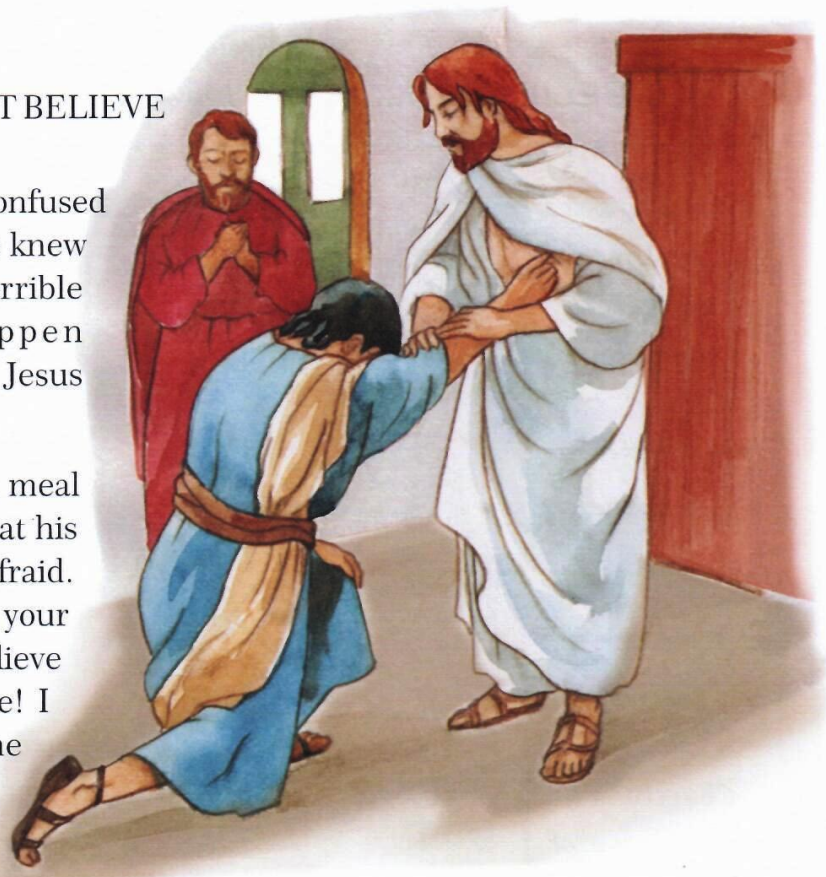

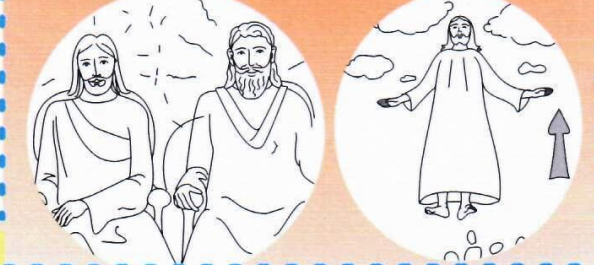
