


King Solomon



David chose Solomon as his successor and the united kingdom of Israel reached the height of its splendour and glory during his reign.



Solomon had a vision of God speaking to him while he was in Gibeon to offer sacrifices. When asked what he wanted, Solomon sought the gift of wisdom to rule his people with justice, and to know the difference between good and evil.

God was extremely pleased that Solomon had not asked for personal or material gains like a long life, wealth and power and granted him the wish. Thus Solomon became a popular king who was much admired by his people for his wise, judicious and far-sighted statesmanship.

His vision was far ahead of his time and his reign became known as the golden age of Israel. Solomon was the most powerful ruler in the region stretching from Euphrates to Egypt. He established diplomatic relations with all his neighbouring countries and married the daughter of the Pharaoh of Egypt, which was unusual for a king of Israel.

The Bible tells a legendary story of how the queen of Sheba, an ancient kingdom in the Arabian Peninsula, decided to visit him and was impressed by the display of magnificence in his court at Jerusalem. The queen even tested Solomon's legendary wisdom and realising everything she had heard about him was true departed from Israel after offering expensive gifts like gold, precious stones and perfumes.

Resentment between the powerful tribes of Israel in the north and south continued to haunt the kingdom, paving the way for a future split.
