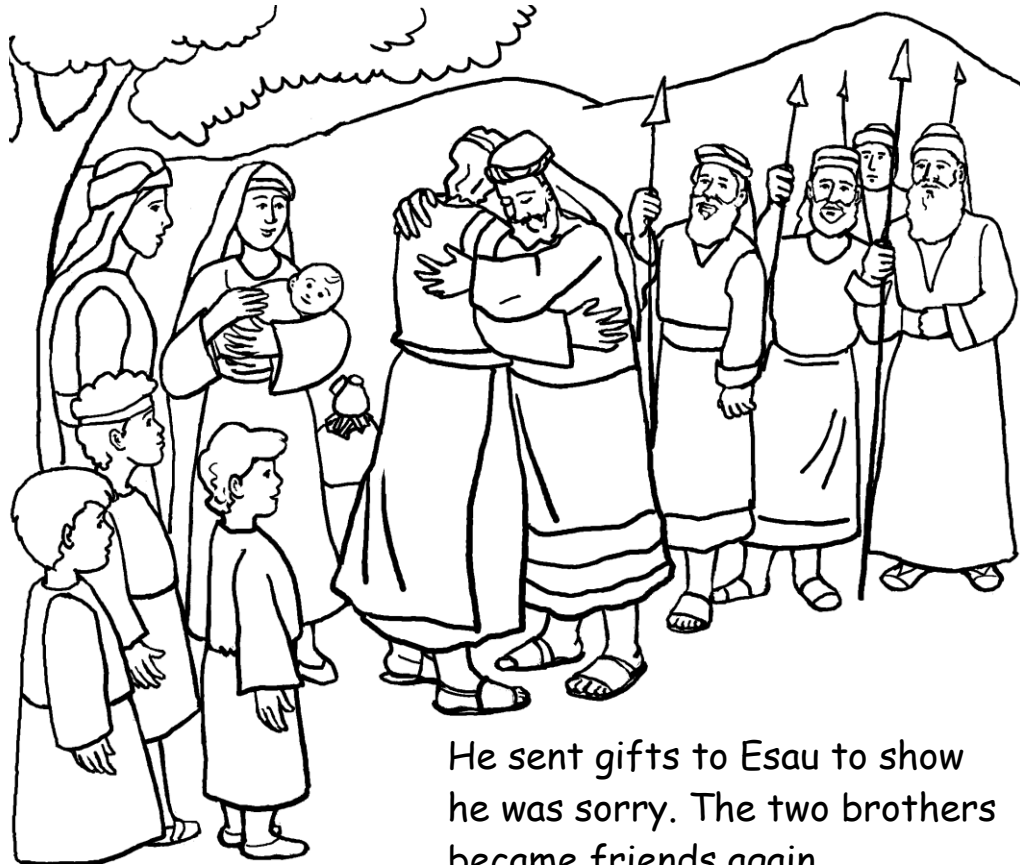


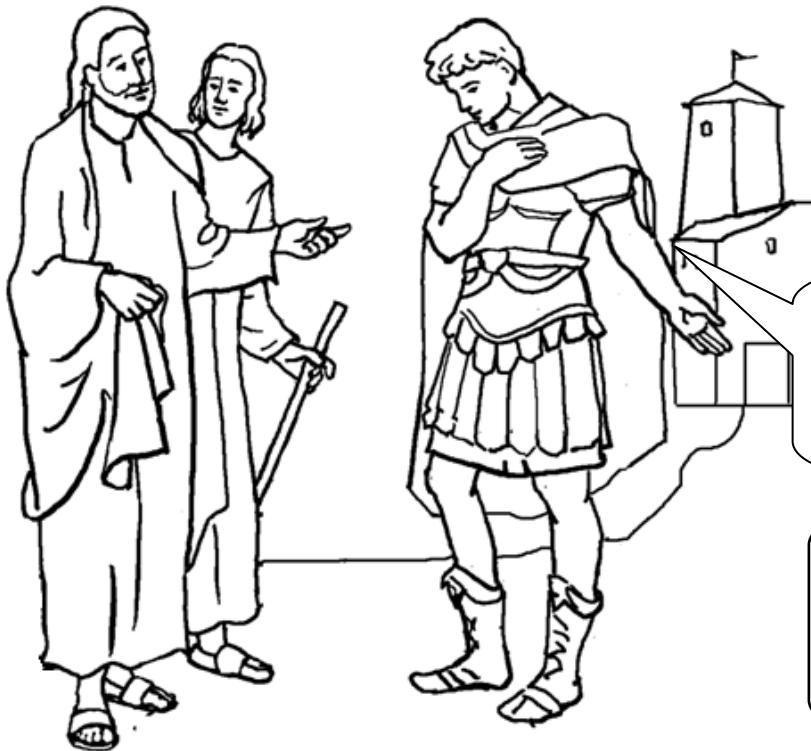
God blessed Jacob. He married Leah and Rachel and had many children. He reared many animals too.
