## UNIT 2: JESUS AND THE NEW COVENANT THE PROMISED ONE COMES

#### Revision

[Do not give the written test at this class!]

- Begin with a short prayer.
- Divide the class into 5 groups. Each group has 10 minutes to read over and prepare a presentation on one lesson [Lessons 7-11 are allotted among the groups]
- They come forward and summarise the lesson, giving the main facts (without looking at the handouts). Other students could question them about any point in the lesson.

MATERIALS NEEDED: Students' files with past handouts.

- If you like, you could allow the students to correct and mark their own papers as you call out the answers.
