Read the prayer over the water. How many signs of Baptism does it talk about? (Mark them!)  
  
What do they tell you about the water of Baptism? What does the water of your Baptism do to you?

**PRAYER OVER THE WATER:**  
*Father .. At the very dawn of creation your Spirit breathed on the waters, making them the wellspring of all holiness.  
The waters of the great flood you made a sign of the waters of Baptism, that make an end of sin and a new beginning of goodness.  
Through the waters of the Red Sea you led Israel out of slavery, to be an image of God's holy people, set free from sin by Baptism.  
In the waters of the Jordan your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Spirit.  
Your Son willed that water and blood should flow from his side as he hung upon the cross.  
By the power of the Spirit give to the water of this font the grace of your Son. You created man in your own likeness: cleanse him from sin in a new birth to innocence by water and the Spirit.  
We ask you, Father, with your Son to send the Holy Spirit upon the water of this font. May all who are buried with Christ in the death of Baptism rise also with him to newness of life.*
